To showcase your dancer and their dance progress. The Zone Staff invites all friends and families by Zoom to observe in-studio class and performance the last week before Christmas Break . The class links will be used for the in-studio performance.

Zone Tuition Policy

The Zone Dance Center, LLC requires monthly payment for the dance year (September-June) by the 1st of every month in your Studio Portal. Invoice will not be sent. Any payments made after the 7th of the month will be assessed a \$15 late fee in addition to the monthly payment. June tuition is due either (1) at the time of registration, or (2) the first week of May.

The Zone Dance Center, LLC reserves the right to cancel and/or change classes due to small class enrollment size.

Recital Costumes All students participating in the June Recital are required to purchase a Recital Costume due **February 1st**.

Pre-dance costumes are \$50. Primary levels and higher \$65; additional \$10 for XL sizes.

Costume deposits are non-refundable. Catalog costumes (\$65) are required for Primary Hip-Hop and Hip-Hop I classes.

Hip-Hop II and Teen Hip-Hop will not require a catalog costume. Students are required to create an individual look within the desired style from teacher (color, theme, etc.) and will be notified in March.

Attire - Zoom and In Studio

The mandatory dress code is designed to enhance the unity and appearance of our students, which ultimately instills proper dance discipline and etiquette. Students/Parents should make an effort to get the hair off of the neck and forehead and into a bun if at all possible. Additionally, students should not wear jewelry in class. The Dress Code Policy will be strictly enforced. Students will be given an initial verbal and/or written notice; subsequent violations will require students to observe class until the Dress Code Policy can be properly followed. Please refer to our Class Attire Regulation Sheet for specifics on the dress code.

Attendance

Students are allowed (2) two make-up classes per semester. Contact the studio for tardiness/absences. Students may be asked to observe if more than 15 minutes late to class. Unless otherwise notified, then student will be dropped from class with more than (3) three consecutive absences in one month. Re-registration will be required.

The Zone Virtual and Hybrid Classes

In the event classes exceed student capacity, The Zone will implement a hybrid model of instruction, a combination of in person and virtual on Zoom. For example, Group A will attend in studio classes from week 1 and week 2, while Group B will take classes virtually by Zoom, week 1 and 2. Weeks 3-4, Group B will attend in-studio instruction and Group A will attend virtual instruction.

For safety precautions, please inform the front desk receptionist and teacher if someone other than the parent is picking up your dancer before class.

Parking: Please use the Promenade Plaza parking lot for all drop off and pick-up. Parking at The Franklin Party Store is strictly prohibited and will result in your car being towed. Thank you for your understanding.

Additional Reopening Rules:

- Pre-Dance I parents are allowed in the building only.
- Pre-Dance II and III, review tap shoe buckling at home.
- Email The Zone for links.
- The dressing room is closed.
- No street shoes are to be worn in the studios.
- Label all clothing items and bags. The Zone is not responsible for lost items.
